PURPOSE AND OVERVIEW (max. 5 sentences)				

The aim of this course is: to develop scientific knowledge, competences and academic skills in the research process in the area of succession law; to develop analytical thinking, through comparison of theoretical stands and the possibility of their application in a real legal environment; to master the scientific methods in studying relevant literature and legal sources, in accordance with the contemporary trends in the development of Succession law as a scientific discipline.

Forms of testamentary disposition in contemporary law. Content and interpretation of a testamentary document. Nullity of will. Limitation of freedom of testamentary dispositions in contemporary legal systems. Legal position of a compulsory (forced) heir. Hereditary claim. Hereditary community. Exercise and legal protection of the right to forced portion. Liability of testator's debts. Donation. Administration of succession estate. Probate

procedure and administrative succession proceedings.
