The aim of this course is to introduce students to institutions, norms and the contents of EU law, to develop the ability to independently identify, understand and critically analyse the institutional framework of the EU and its legislation, and to apply such knowledge in specific situations.

Membership and external relations: Criteria for membership. Admission procedure. Relations with non-member countries.
