PURPOSE AND OVERVIEW (max. 5 sentences)

Aims: to introduce students to the system of dispute resolution mechanisms: litigation, arbitration, mediation, negotiation and others; to provide insight into the advantages and disadvantages of dispute resolution methods; to enable students to recognize appropriate method for resolving different types of disputes; to provide relevant skills for the practical application of consensual dispute resolution methods.
