## MASTER IN EUROPEAN INTEGRATION at the University of Belgrade Faculty of Law

We would like to inform You that the University of Belgrade Faculty of Law is announcing the enrollment for the seventh generation of master students in the Master Academic Program - MASTER IN EUROPEAN INTEGRATION, academic year 2014/2015.

Master Academic Studies - MASTER IN EUROPEAN INTEGRATION - have been implemented at the Belgrade University Faculty of Law since academic year 2008/2009. This master program is granted with the National Academic Accreditation, as well as with the reaccreditation after the first five years of implementation, and can enroll up to 70 students each academic year. The official language of the program is English. The program is also open to foreign students.

The duration of the Master Academic Program - MASTER IN EUROPEAN INTEGRATION is 30 weeks, and it is worth 60 ECTS. Students must attend three mandatory/introductory courses — Introduction to the Economic System of the EU, Introduction to the Political System of the EU, Introduction to the Legal System of the EU, as well as the Practical Skills course. Additionally, students opt for four courses among twenty one offered courses. Each course has been conducted in the block of classes held during five or six weeks. Each student also has an obligation to write and defend one seminar paper and master thesis.

Introduction to the Legal System of the EU course - 5 ECTS Introduction to the Political System of the EU course - 5 ECTS Introduction to the Economic System of the EU course - 5 ECTS One optional course - 6 ECTS (4x6=24 ECTS) Practical Skills - 3 ECTS Seminar paper - 5 ECTS Final Master paper - 13 ECTS

In order to become eligible for enrollment in this program, students must possess a Bachelor's Degree from the field of law or social sciences - humanities, with at least 240 ECTS.

Students who graduated from social sciences, shall be obliged to pass differential exams. (Main Rulebook, Article 5).

Additional courses are organized each school year, and students receive certificates for attending them.

The enrollment notification will be published in mid-September 2014 in the newspaper Politika and on the Faculty website.

The tuition fee for domestic students is 140.000 dinars, for students from the region of the Former Yugoslavia is 168.000 dinars, and for foreign students 2.000 EUR.
